### (1) High Risk Mares

Mares who have had previous contact with CEMO over the past two years or who originate from countries other than France, Germany, England, Ireland, Italy, USA and Canada >>> Before covering oestrus : 3 negative clitoral & cervical (culture) swabs to be taken after 1st January 2024:

- one to be taken in the country of residence
- the other two to be taken in France

### (2) If positive EVA

Mare with a positive EVA blood result require another blood test taken within 14 days of the first sample and from the same laboratory - The mare will be approved if showing a stable or declining EVA titer

### (3) Vaccinations required

One EHV 1-4 + Equine Influenza vaccine every 6 months - Vet certificate to be completed and returned to Haras de Bonneval.

\* Any mare needing another cover on a different cycle will need to have a clean cervical swab.
