FLU AND EHV 1.4

Every 6 months

IF BREAK IN THE VACCINATION

New primary vaccination
before the 1st cover with 2 injections
spaced from 21 to 60 days apart

**High risk mares: Mares who have had previous contact with CEMO over the past two years or who originate from countries other than France, Germany, England, Ireland, Italy, USA and Canada: 3 negative clitoral and cervical swabs (culture) to be taken after 1st January 25 (one to be taken in the country of residence and the other two to be taken in France).*

EVA TEST

Negative EVA test dated **less than 30 days**
before the 1st cover (seroconversion method).

⚠ An EVA test done at the French
boarding stud will be required for mares
coming from abroad (Elisa accepted
if the first result is in seroconversion).

IF POSITIVE RESULT

Blood test taken within 14 days
of the first sample and **from**
the same laboratory. The mare will
be approved if showing a stable
or declining EVA titer.

COGGINS

COGGINS TEST

Equine Infectious Anemia (recommended)
Coggins Test to be done within 30 days prior to arrival in France.



COMPULSORY
for mares coming from
ITALY

COGGINS TEST

1 negative test

Dated no more than
21 days prior to the cover.

DOURINE TEST

2 negative tests

2 negative blood tests taken no more
than 28 days prior to arrival in France
AND the second one to be taken at least
14 days after arrival at the French boarding farm.

If the mare changes stallion or relocates to a new boarding farm during the breeding season:
NEW TESTS (ALL) WILL BE REQUIRED
